CLF AT 30: A TIMELINE

The Children's Lifesaving Foundation was founded in 1993 by Maria D'Angela, after she had been volunteering at a homeless shelter in Central Los Angeles. She began by bringing children to get necessary physicals and minor surgeries, and soon began organizing field trips to amusement parks and local attractions

Dr. Chris Landon Introduced her to the National Park Service in 1993, and with a great group of like-minded friends and volunteers (including some emazing members of the Agape International Spiritual Institute) she helped refurbish the Circle X Ranch in the Santa Monica Mountains. In the summer of 1993, she brought up the first group of seven children. Our Summer Camp Enrichment Program was born. By 1994, the CLF was serving over 2,200 youth and families from various homeless shelters and agencies serving underserved youth annually.





Seeing the need to provide an amazing Holiday Experience for underserved youth, friends at companies such as California Supply, Topson-Downs, KAYO, and Disney started sponsoring what would soon become known as our Project Angel Wings Holiday Program. Over 100 college scholarships have been awarded to deserving teens to date_

in the period between starting the camp program in 1993 and 1965, the CLF began finding financial sponsors to move specific families out of homeless shelters, and into their own homes. These families formed a group called the Adopt-A-Family Program, and, Later, formed a program called the Vita Network. Robyn Moore and ICON Pictures, along with Michael Torrey of Nobye Moore and norm for the way first sponsors of their construction, became some of the very first sponsors of their program-which gree to move over 50 families and individuals in need ifrom homeless shetters and transitional Toster housing into new apartments.

The CLF's three programs continue to grow and thrive, the CLF stiull making Camp for All its home base at Circle X Ranch through the summer of 2005... Field Trips to cultural and recreational events are added as a program component to the **Care though College Program. Partnerships with** agencies such as LA's BEST and Homeboy Industries and countless other agencies serving homeless families and underserved youth are established

Hearing the need of the families in our Vita Network for homework assistance and test preparation for their elementary-school aged children, the CLF started the Care though **College Program, opening a special Learning** Center on Main Street in Santa Monica...

The CLF moved its Care though College Program to operate out of the Boys & Girls club of Venice, continuing to run our three other programs year-round, and getting nationally recognized with several awards, appearing on The Steve Harvey Show in 2013.

During the pandemic, a new program was created to provide emergency funding for highly vulnerable families, called The Step Forward Emergency Family Fund. It gave away over \$150,000 in direct cash stipends and in-kind donations during the lock-down and Covid Pandemic. The CLF continues to grow, adding more corporate sponsors and foundations, and an amazing roster of volunteers and supporters. Today, in 2023, CLF has served over 85,000
